Our university formed a dedicated team of administrators, faculty members, and stakeholders to lead the implementation process. This team should include individuals from various disciplines and should be responsible for planning, execution, and monitoring to

Implement NEP-2020 at our University.

Apart from this our University developed a system to monitor and evaluate the implementation of NEP-2020. Establish quality assurance mechanisms to assess the effectiveness of the curriculum, teaching practices, and student outcomes. Collect feedback from students, faculty, and stakeholders to drive continuous improvement.

Adapting Curriculum as per the NEP-2020:

We are in process to review the existing curriculum and make necessary changes to align it with the NEP-2020 recommendations. Emphasize interdisciplinary and holistic learning, skill development, and experiential learning opportunities. Incorporate flexibility and choice-based credit systems, allowing students to pursue subjects of their interest.

Admission Paths for Undergraduate Programme:

Students who have successfully completed Grade 12 School Leaving Certificate shall be eligible for admission to a first-degree programme. The admission shall be made on merit on the basis of criteria keeping in view the guidelines/norms in this regard issued by the UGC and other statutory bodies concerned and considering the reservation policy issued by the government concerned from time to time.

The University is under process to implement the guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education Institutions. Student enrolment shall be in accordance with the academic and physical facilities available keeping in mind the norms regarding the student-teacher ratio, the teaching-non-teaching staff ratio, laboratory, library, teaching-learning tools.

The in-take capacity shall be determined at least three months in advance by through academic bodies in accordance with the guidelines/norms in this regard issued by the UGC and other statutory bodies
